

Regulations

The Gruyère Cycling Tour is a popular cycling ride for amateurs open to everyone, licensed or not licensed men and women (from 18 years old and over). The race is timed and the subject of a rankings.

The results will be communicated after the race and will be available on www.gruyere-cycling-tour.ch. The event takes place on open roads to traffic.

Wearing a helmet is obligatory. The participants must respect the Highway Code and comply with the instructions of the official superintendents.

The Swiss participants' bikes must have a license plate sticker on. Accompanying vehicles are forbidden.

For security reasons, the participants of the Sunday race have the **obligation to wear the jersey free given by the organizer** at the inscription.

The bibs will be done on Saturday during the Weekend of the race between 14h30 and 18h00 pm and/or on Sunday during the race between 06h00 et 08h30 am.

Participation to the UCI World Cycling Tour (UWCT)

The UCI World Cycling Tour is a new series of events for amateurs. Through seven qualifiers events around the world, riders can obtain a place to participate in the UWCT Final, with a world title for their respective age group as the ultimate goal.

The registration to this event acts as a daily license for the participant. By registering himself, he gives, at the same time, his agreement for the use of his data by Swiss Cycling. The participant/undersigned declares to be in possession of a Liability Insurance to be admitted and being informed that doping tests may be done during the event.

The rankings at The Gruyère Cycling Tour for the UWCT can only be made on the 125km run. As the last Gruyère Cycling Tour's editions, the race is open to everybody. The riders who want to start within the first group of 400 riders must absolutely justify this presence by convincing results in other national cyclist races (Being in the 10 first riders of the Gruyère Cycling Tour 2010, in the 10 first riders of an important national race and having a license). The request has to be done before 15th August 2011 (by post or e-mail) to the organizer Sports Evénements.

At the end of each race, the 25% best age-groupers in each qualifier event (also valid for the Challenge Enterprise category) will automatically have the right to compete in the UWCT Final. Obligatory attendance is required on the podium for the classified riders as from 3:30 pm at the Espace Gruyère.

For the participation to the UCI World Cycling Tour's rankings, the UCI's regulations prevail.

Ages categories and rankings

The events give results into different ages categories, as for women than for men:

- 16 - 29 years old (Challenger category)
- 30 - 34 years old
- 35 - 39 years old
- 40 - 44 years old
- 45 - 49 years old
- 50 - 54 years old
- 55 - 59 years old
- 60 - 64 years old
- over 65 years old

The age category you are in corresponds to the age you will reach at 31st December 2011.

Insurance and exclusion

Liability Insurance and Accidents

Each participant must have these two insurances. Foreign participants must provide before the start a proof of Liability/accidents insurance valid outside their origin country. It is possible to contract a Liability-Accident Insurance directly on the spot (Informations Vaudoise assurances, Bulle).

Every cost resulting from medical care (ambulance, doctor, hospital, etc.) or technical care (spare parts) are in charge of the participant.
